
When host click Stop Webcast, the streaming stops immediately.






Open Embedded Apps: Improve Discoverability Available at GA

Real-time Transcription for 13 Spoken Languages Available at GA


Host selects transcription for the meeting in 13 spoken languages

- English (existing), Chinese Mandarin (Simplified and Traditional), Dutch, French, German, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Polish, Portuguese, and Spanish
- Captions for these languages can also be translated to 100+ other languages.

• This feature will have a beta tag, and an improvement in the way that captions are rendered is planned for release in 42.3.






Real-time Transcription for 13 Spoken Languages Available at GA

Captions box above the meeting controls show the participant selected caption language

Captions panel on the right hand side show the selected spoken language

If the meeting recorded, then the recording video's embedded transcript will be populated only if the speaking language is in english

If Webex Assistant is also available (either on or off) in the recorded meeting, then the Review tab under Calendar in the webex app will show the transcription in the selected spoken language.



Meetings where privacy (anonymity) is required between attendees

New option in scheduler "Keep attendee names private"

- setting assigns an anonymous display name ("Participant 1", "Participant 2", etc.) to attendees as they join.
- Attendees will not be able to see each other's real names.
- Only the host/cohost will have access to see an attendee's real name.

Example Use Cases

- Holding a meeting with competing vendors
- Alcoholics Anonymous, medical consultations

Users joining external meetings now on Webex for Government

Join policy: Administrators can now turn on a setting for their organization which prevents all their company users from joining any external meetings. This setting also provides capability for you to add sites to the "approved site" list there by controlling which sites your company users can join or be blocked.

Meetings setting: Administrators – You can now restrict your company users to use certain "in-meeting" features, that go against your company policies when joining meetings outside of your organization.

The following features can be blocked for your users in this release: File transfer, screen share +Annotation, Chat, Q&A & polling.

You can add your own approved site list where you want these restrictions not to take effect. This setting can be configured using the Control Hub site administration page. If turned on for your company, this policy is applied to all users in your organization joining from mobile, desktop, and browser using your company's verified domain email address to join meetings.

- Currently this setting is applicable to ALL users in the organization and anyone using your company's claimed domain email address to join meetings.
- The join policy setting is applicable for Webex Meetings only




Background PIP Mode on iPads

- The active speaker video will pause when the bluetooth connection is lost (system behavior), user need tap button to resume the video.







Change the default skin tone for your message reactions in Webex in settings/preferences. Choose from six different options. See other peoples' selections as they react to messages.

- Select a skintone clour in app Settings/preferences new option in appearance tab
- When selected, that skintone colour will then show across all my clients in reaction options on a message
- My selected skintone colour should be the same in all my devices & webex meetings
- When I react to something in the message area, I will see my selected skin tone added to the reaction count on that message
- If I hover over the reaction count of a message, I will see all the different skin tone reactions made on that message
- For each user who reacted, I will also see what their selected skintone reaction was when they added that reaction
- I expect that all my previous reactions on messages, before I updated the skintone for my reactions, will be in the original default yellow colour
- Dialog pop up when you first go to add a reaction after this update – inform about skintone reactions that links you to appearance settings

The Purpose of this feature is to infuse trust with end users on the matter of security & privacy to make them feel secure and their conversation private.

- With Extended Security Pack, admins can choose to enable anti-malware scanning for files uploaded in Webex. Webex anti-malware capabilities are powered by Cisco Talos ClamAV.
- When people upload files in Webex, the files are scanned for malware and :
 - 1) In case of good files: End users are not indicated that the file about the scan results if the file is good file. The end user is not aware about the antimalware scan results unless it is a bad file the file.
 - 2) In case of bad files: people won't be able to download or preview the file. When files are first uploaded, they are automatically quarantined for evaluation and users can't download or preview the file during the evaluation period. We can enhance the end user experience for malicious files detection by providing more information to the end user.





 - Desk Pro, Desk LE, Desk, Desk Mini, and Desk Hub
 - Considering other devices
- Reduce ultrasound noise in open environments
 - If users are already connecting to the device with a wire, no need for ultrasound
- Supported on Webex-registered devices only
 - Cloud connectivity required to fetch tokens
- USB-C (Device-side) to USB-A (PC-side) supported
 - No support for USB-A device-side connections




Closed Captioning and Real-time Translation

- Help meet accessibility requirements for devices
- Support for current portfolio (RoomOS 11)
 - Webex-registered devices only
 - Requires Webex Assistant subscription
 - Host or cohost enabled Webex Assistant in the meeting
 - Enabled per user on their device
- Enabling Closed Captioning limits grid size to 3x3
- Support for all Webex languages

Persistent WebApps on Room Navigator

- Provide a full screen web view to deploy apps to Webex Room Navigators
 - Replace the native RoomOS UI with a WebApp
 - I.E. Appspace, DNA Spaces, other booking tools
 - Provisioned through Control Hub
 - Allows for control of the LED on wall-mounted units
- Adds flexibility for customers to keep or enhance their existing space management and/or signage solutions
 - · Added value from Webex Room Navigator
- Only supported on remotely/IP-paired Navigators
 - No support from behind codec/device










ECM Storage for Whiteboards Outside of Webex - One Drive

- Whiteboards can now be saved to One Drive
- Login with your One Drive credentials on the device
- · Open existing whiteboards in your One Drive
- Import local whiteboards into One Drive for sharing
- PDF whiteboards can also be opened again and edited as whiteboards
- Other ECMs are on the roadmap





Control Hub Device Macro Provisioning

- · Supports provisioning macros per device in CH
 - · Does not support bulk provisioning
- Upload macros from CH to deploy to Webex devices
- Disable or enable macro runtime on a device




