

Today, paid customers have 2 options to create a new site - SA or Control Hub managed site


Our goal is to have all Meetings sites managed in Control Hub which is the single of pane glass for management




42.6 update is the <u>final</u> release of Productivity Tools




Update Error Messages for Meeting Start/Join Available at GA

During a meeting or a webinar, Windows & Mac users can now share their built-in or external camera content as if they are sharing their screen.

 When speaker share built-in camera as content sharing source, self video will continue to work.


Attendees can see

- what the user is sharing via camera in full screen mode
- self video of the participant who is sharing camera content.

Note:

- This feature will NOT work for Webex Events Classic & Training Center
- In this phase, user will not be able to see participant video thumbnails once sharing using camera has started. This will be enhanced in 42.7






New layout tab to set max number (4-81) of videos in grid view

Based upon available bandwidth and CPU utilization, number of videos will be scaled down (25 or 6) or up automatically

Bandwidth requirements:

- -3.5Mbps for 7x7




Participant Privacy Setting


Enable Embedded Apps (EA) for User Groups Custom Schedule

Allows Control Hub admins to enable EA for a group of users

Use Cases:

IT can have a few users to test a new app before releasing it to the entire org Assign app to specific users based upon business need to save software license cost

Now, Slido can be assigned to group of users instead of the entire org

RESTful APIs: Webhooks


When meeting transcripts are ready

Webhooks are great way to provide notifications

 Use to execute specific business logic based on the status received from the Webhook

In this update, API provides ability to receive a webhook once meeting transcripts are ready

 Address use cases such as sending out emails to meeting participants to inform them about the transcription readiness





Message Prompt for Collaboration Restressures

Compliance Controls on Annotation and Whiteboard

When users are restricted from using annotation and whiteboard

- If someone started annotating, they can't see the share and annotation but will see a message about them being restricted from seeing those content.
 After annotation are stopped, they will see the content share again
- Similarly, if whiteboard is being shared, those users will see a message about them being restricted from seeing those content



Miracast content sharing



Miracast® provides a wireless content sharing solution without the need for a client or a connection to the guest/enterprise network as a direct network connection is established from the Windows PC/Android device to the Webex device using Wi-Fi Direct.

- Requires RoomOS 11 UI
- Webex device must be on ethernet connection (not wireless)
- Senders hardware must support Wi-Fi Direct
- Webex devices support Wi-Fi Direct receiver on 2.4Ghz frequency band
- Share resolution up to 1080p60 with H.264 video





Admin controlled

If the administrator wants to control Miracast availability, then xCommand can be used to enable:

xCommand Video Input Miracast Mode: On

By default, the above command is set to Off.

With Miracast Mode turned on, it will always be visible to the end user


User controlled

If the administrator wants the end user to control Miracast availability, then xCommand can be used:

xCommand Video Input Miracast Mode: Manual

By default, the above command is set to Off.

With Miracast Mode turned to Manual, the end user will be able to turn it on or off from the UI. With it turned off, the home page of the device will not show Miracast icon.




- There are two versions of the Wi-Fi Display Technical Specification, R1 and R2.
 - Webex devices currently only support R1
 - Webex Desk Hub does not support Miracast
 - · Webex devices do not support HDCP over Miracast. Some Android devices require HDCP support.
 - If the Webex device has Wi-Fi antennas, please fit them (Codec Pro)
- Webex devices use TCP port 7236 for Miracast signaling
 - · Miracast will not work if this port is blocked on the sender device
- Devices with built-in Miracast support:
 - Windows 8.1 and above
 - Android 4.2 and above (not supported by Google Pixel devices)
 - Device must support Wi-Fi Direct
- Webex devices are not Miracast certified by the Wi-Fi Alliance
 - Cannot use the term 'Wi-Fi Certified Miracast™'

 - Device needs to have Cloud Upgrade Mode enabled
- Software release will still show RoomOS 10.x.x.x
 - Will move to 11.x.x.x once Room systems are added








Update via 'edit your profile' in the app


Choose from a list or specify a custom pronoun

- Users should have a way to set their pronoun in their user profile (edit profile)







Previously the current name of the group would show in the text below the title. As an update to this, we will show the current name of the group as hint text in the input field



Airline Wi-Fi: Block Real-Time Capabilities

- Detect that we're on a wi-fi network on which we should block real-time communication and any features that would utilize significant bandwidth for upload
- When the user attempts to initiate a real-time interaction, stop that action in the client.
 - Calling someone
 - Starting a meeting
 - Answering a call
 - Joining a meeting
 - Uploading a large attachment
 - Sending a voice clip (mobile)
 - Updating the app
 - Other items that would require significant upload bandwidth.
- At the time we block the action, display a helpful
 2022 cinformational message to the user about the reason for the error.











Users frequently forget to send a message they have typed or write a message to send later and forget about it. The only way to view these is to check drafts filter, which is not discoverable

With this UX enhancement we are adding a visual indicator to remind user when the are looking at the spaces that they have a message they have not send.



Calling

Multi Call Webex Calling Exec / Assistant Support




If the user is using Executive-Assistant, they are sharing a line with others. But they currently cannot monitor the line status of executives (if they are an assistant) or assistants (if they are an exec).

With this feature now For shared line use case, user A can see if other members in the same line are on a call, so they know how to handle the call.



Share Line / Multi-line Support Privacy On/Off




For shared line use case, we need support Busy Lamp Field (BLF) feature, so that user A can see if other members in the same line on a call/hold a call or other calling status, this feature is critical to migrate agent customers from physical phone and CIPC to Webex.






Noise Removal for PSTN Calls (Receiving Side Noise)



•Innovation to give better calling experience to calling users when they talk to non-WxApp users such as PSTN / Phones etc...




Support Transfer During Call Hold




On a mobile device, a Webex app user will not really be able to continue the conversation with customer during the searching / dialing the person they are transferring to phone number. So to properly care for customers experience is important for the transfer experience better.

With this enhancement Now the Webex app user will be able to place the customer on hold and search for the person we are transferring to and do a transfer while the person is on hold.

RDC over 1:1 call





Remote Desktop control is one of the key feature for modern hybrid work style when collaboration becomes more remote. Cisco Webex Meeting app and Jabber both support RDC in different ways and it is was critical feature to enable customer to update from Webex Meeting app and Jabber to Webex app with unified experience.
